Recycle and Reuse

In consultation with our supplier abroad, we have collaborated with a local Stone organisation to Recycle and Reuse Aspect Vivid by...

- 1. Crushing and Pulverising the discarded Aspect into powder.
- 2. Mixing Aspect Vivid powder with cement, gypsum powder and water within a high speed mixer.
- 3. Pouring the resulted mixture into moulds.
- 4. Drying the newly formed bricks in the drying yard.
- 5. To then pack on a recycled timber pallet.

Repurpose

Remnants and pieces larger than 150mm x 200mm generated on Australian project sites are collected and returned to either a distributor or to Stonewall Platinum, where it is re-used as sampling to facilitate future projects, i.e.; Re-purpose existing.

PHILANTHROPIC

As part of our commitment to philanthropics, we give back to the community by providing an ongoing charitable donation to the Australian Institute of Policing, a Youth publication called "The Street Smart Handbook" dedicated to assisting the youth, through the transition of secondary schooling to the workforce and lastly an ongoing yearly sponsorship of the Rossmoyne Bowling Club.
